### **Bookings & Reservation**

- ETA tours may require a deposit to confirm your reservation.
- Day Tours are due & payable 30 days prior to tour date or the seat may be sold.
- Day Tours involving train, boats, meals or admissions are due & payable at time of booking.
- All casino tours are payable at time of booking.
